**The “Soil Perception for Nature and Countryside Guides” project received an award as part of the “BodenWertSchätzen” competition organized by the German Federal Environmental Foundation!**

We are very happy about getting third prize in the "Education and Public Relations" category of this nationwide competition! It will help us to promote this new initiative within the nature guide profession to foster soil awareness and soil perception!

Dr. Dorothe Lütkemöller represented Terolog GmbH in a group of 160 applicants, winning third place in the "education and public relations" category, with a 2,000 Euro prize.

At the award ceremony in Osnabrück, the winners of the nationwide competition, determined by an expert jury, were announced and they received their awards. Award winners and runners-up were delighted with the total of 75,000 Euros in prize money from the German Council for Sustainable Development (RNE) and the German Federal Environmental Foundation (DBU).
